Much of the meeting was spent talking about the upcoming Soup & Salad luncheon and the jobs that people have taken on and what still needs to be done and donated. The ladies are ready to get started very early on October 14th, since we won't be able to get into the gym on Saturday.

The meeting ended about 7:45 when people started picking up their leftover food and leaving the gym for the evening.
