

Sts. Peter & Paul Parish Council Minutes- March 12, 2019

Finance Report: No report. The meeting in February was cancelled due to bad weather.

Consortium Report: Principal Andrew Bauer informed the council that 193 students have registered for the next school year. Also, there is a waiting list to sign up for kindergarten. He also told us the final profit from this years Trivia Night held on March 9th was \$8,212. This was more than last years total with fewer tables this year. Federal funds are available to have summer school for the month of June for students in need of additional learning. Finally, federal funds have been spent to update appliances in the cafeteria.

Religious Education Report: No report.

Resource Committee Report: John Garner said as soon as weather permitted, more outdoor lighting around the grounds will be replaced with new LED bulbs.

Fun(d) Committee Report: Pat Cheloha said because of the positive feedback and results of last years Tailgate Party, another one will be planned for the Husker/ Colorado game in the fall.

Pastors Report: Father Jindra will post a notice in the bulletin about the need for EME Training for Communion Service when a priest is not available. Meetings are continuing for the Strategic Planning Committee, which will integrate our community as one parish family.

New Business: Cool Cash Fundraiser- with the new boiler paid off, we now turn our attention to the new A/C systems needed. A taco dinner will be held on the weekend of March 23/24th. Proceeds will go to paying for the new A/C. A June fundraiser is also being planned. An April election is planned for 3 seats on the Parish Council. Jim Maninelli from Mater Filius was at the meeting to give us an update on their operation in the convent. There is a great demand for their services, as they continue to grow.
